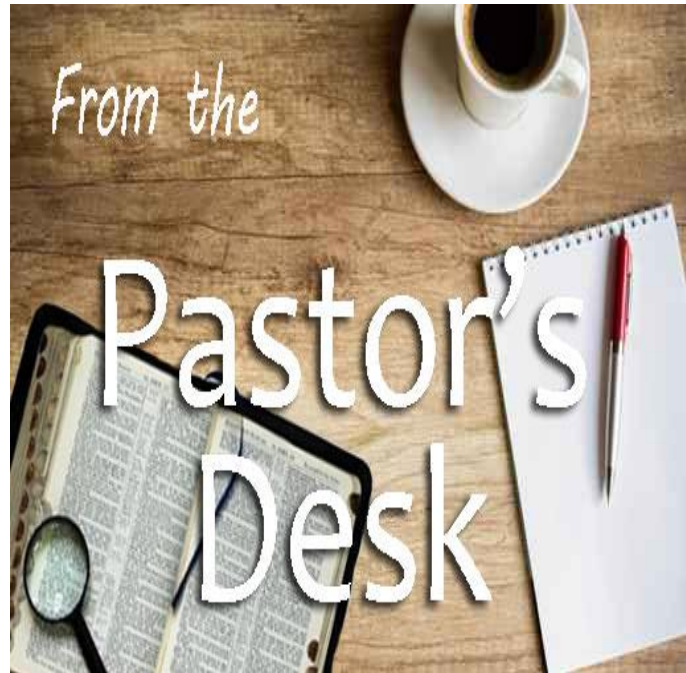

**Please see the information below from our amazing finance committee! The month is finally upon us. The annual conference is fast approaching as well as July 1<sup>st</sup>. It is such a busy and exciting time for our church!!!!**

FINANCIAL UPDATE 5-31-23 THE FINANCE COMMITTEE IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE WE HAVE PAID ALL BUT \$30,785.00 OF THE \$125,551.00 DISAFFILIATION FEE WITHOUT HAVING TO USE OUR ANNUITY RESERVE MONIES. OUR CHURCH HAS BEEN ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH THIS WITH PLEDGES, FUNDRAISERS, AND FAITHFUL GIVING OVER AND ABOVE TITHES. YEAR TO DATE, OUR BUDGET HAS BEEN MET AS WELL! STARTING JUNE 1ST AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 10TH, WE WILL BE SELLING TICKETS, (\$20 PER TICKET), FOR A CHANCE TO WIN THE HOPE CHEST THAT TIM DORKOFF MADE AND DONATED TO THE FINANCE COMMITTEE FOR THE DISAFFILIATION EXPENSE. AT THE CHURCH PICNIC, SEPTEMBER 10TH, THE WINNING TICKET WILL BE SELECTED. THE REQUEST FOR A CRAFTED WOODWORKING PROJECT ENDED WITH A SPIRITUAL JOURNEY FOR TIM..... THE HOPE CHEST IS MADE FROM TWELVE DIFFERENT SPECIES OF WOOD: 1.MAPLE 2.BEECH 3.HICKORY 4.RED ELM 5.BLACK WALNUT 6.SPALTED OAK 7.ASH 8.ENGLISH WALNUT 9.OAK 10.CHERRY 11.CEDAR 12.POPLAR WHILE CREATING THE HOPE CHEST, TIM LIKENED THE TWELVE TYPES OF WOOD TO THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE NUMBER TWELVE WHICH IS USED 187 TIMES THROUGHOUT THE BIBLE; THE 12 APOSTLES, THE 12 TRIBES OF ISRAEL, AND THE NEW JERUSALEM HAS 12 GATES MANNED BY 12 ANGELS. THESE ARE JUST A FEW EXAMPLES OF THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE NUMBER TWELVE. THE ENGRAVED SYMBOL ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE CHEST SIGNIFIES THE TRINITY WHILE THE SYMBOL ON THE LEFT SIDE IS THE GLOBAL METHODIST SYMBOL. MANY THANKS TO TIM FOR SHARING HIS CRAFTSMANSHIP. ## Church Picnic

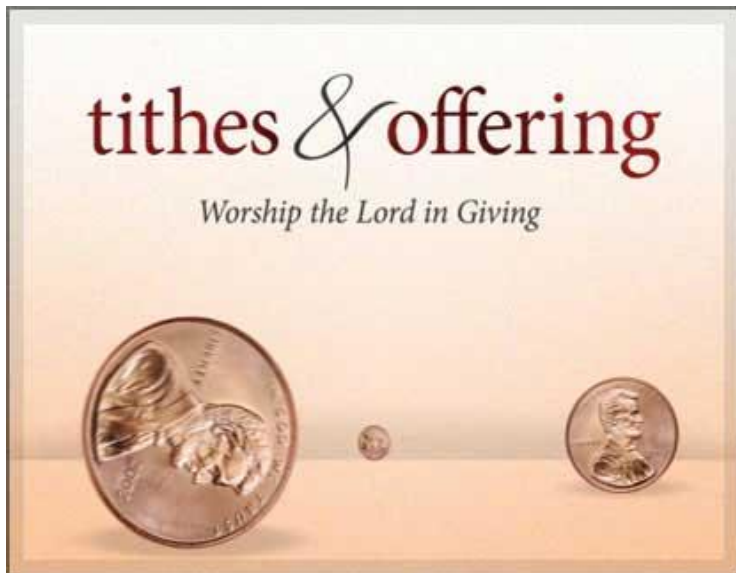

The Fairless Food Cupboard is seeking donations of pasta, pasta sauce, popcorn and seasonings. Any and all donations of nonperishable food items, personal hygiene products and cleaning supplies are gratefully accepted. Donations can be placed under the stairs at the worship entrance.

Operation Christmas Child suggests donations of small toys and baby dolls for June. All donations of coloring books, crayons, school supplies, etc. are always appreciated. Donations can be placed in the container by the worship entrance.

The St Pauly used clothing shed had a big month in donations in May because of the garage sales going on. A lot of unsold clothing ends up in the shed. We accept all used clothing, shoes, belts, purses, blankets, sheets, pillowcases, curtains, and stuffed toys. Please place donations in plastic bags to help keep them dry.

This year's mission trip will be to Oak Hill, WV. We leave Sunday June 18<sup>th</sup> after worship and return Saturday the 24<sup>th</sup>. Those going to are Pastor Carl; Ken Jones; Mike, Cadyn, Jenna, and Andrew McKelvey; Hunter Miller; Persephone, Evelyn, Quentin Luckring and Tim Mihal

We will be serving with other local churches. The mission trip is geared to let the youth work, serve, and learn. The 6 youth from Fohl have been learning how to use tools this past Sunday school year while building the shed. They will be able to use the tools and toolbox they received for participating in building the shed.

You can still help make this a successful mission trip:

- Please pray for us. Pray for safe travel and safe work sites. We will probably be working on homes of those in need and building wheelchair ramps.
- You can still donate money to help us cover our travel expenses such as gas, EZ passes, and travel meals. The fees to go (\$220 per person) have been raised. The adults are paying their own way and the generous donations of the congregation and Gabe and the Youth Group, helped us to raise the funds to reach our goal. If you would still like to donate any amount, just place your donation in the offering plate and designate it for the mission trip. This donation should be over and above your usual giving.
